



ASBESTOS SAFETY TRAINING COURSES



10675NAT COURSE IN ASBESTOS AWARENESS



This course is aimed at workers who in their fields of work may be potentially exposed to asbestos or asbestos containing material. The course is designed to give participants the knowledge to identify and report asbestos containing materials.

Duration: 4 hours

Student/Trainer Ratio: 20:1

Prerequisites & Entry Requirements

There are no prerequisites for 10675NAT Course in Asbestos Awareness

Where this course is being run on the same day as 10559NAT Course in Working Safely with Asbestos Containing Materials, the participant must be deemed competent in this course prior to proceeding with the second half of the day. All students must be eligible to receive nationally recognised training within Australia and provide a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI) upon enrolment.

Who should attend?

This training is mandatory in the ACT, for all workers who the PCBU [a Person Conducting a Business or Undertaking, e.g. an employer] reasonably believes will work with asbestos or asbestos containing material. The training applies not only to supervisors but to everyone from entry level to senior management. It applies not just to builders but to the broadest range of people working on homes and property, including cleaners, architects, plumbers, labourers, landscapers, engineers, fencers, glaziers, locksmiths, professional handymen, construction workers, air-conditioning technicians, plumbers, electricians and anyone else who may come into contact with asbestos containing materials. It is recommended that participants have year 10 level reading and writing capabilities.

Course Objectives and Content

- Knowledge and skills to identify when and where asbestos and asbestos containing materials (ACM) may be present
- Knowledge of the hazards and risks associated with asbestos exposure and inhalation
- Precautions that need to be taken if asbestos is present
- Reporting procedures
- An understanding of each individuals general duty of care

10559NAT COURSE IN WORKING SAFELY WITH ASBESTOS CONTAINING MATERIALS

This course was developed in response to industry consultation and government consultation aiming to bridge the gap between the course in asbestos awareness, asbestos removal, supervision and assessment. It covers skills and knowledge in worksite preparation, PPE requirements, safe drilling and decontamination.

Duration: 4 hours

Prerequisites & Entry Requirements

There is a prerequisite for 10559NAT Course in Working Safely with Asbestos Containing Materials:

10675NAT Course in Asbestos Awareness

Participants must be able to present the Statement of Attainment for verification prior to course commencement. Participants who cannot present evidence of prerequisite qualifications will not be able to participate in the course.

Where this course is being run on the same day as 10675NAT Course in Asbestos Awareness, the participant must be deemed competent prior to moving into this course at the second half of the day.

All students must be eligible to receive nationally recognised training within Australia and provide a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI) upon enrolment.

Who should attend?

Any person who in their workplace may be required to work with existing asbestos cement sheeting (AC sheet) or other asbestos containing materials in and around residential dwellings and commercial premises. The training applies not only to supervisors but to everyone from entry level to senior management. It applies not just to builders but to the broadest range of people working on homes and property, including cleaners, architects, plumbers, labourers, landscapers, engineers, fencers, glaziers, locksmiths and professional handymen.

It is recommended that participants have year 10 level reading and writing capabilities.

This course is a mandatory requirement for any person working in the ACT in the following occupation types and anyone else who may come into contact with asbestos containing materials:

- Air-conditioning and Mechanical Services Plumber
- Air-conditioning and Refrigeration Mechanic
- Cabler (Data and Telecommunications)
- Electrical or Telecommunications Trades Assistant
- Electrician (General & Special Class)
- Gas Fitter
- Plumber (General)
- Plumber's Assistant
- Telecommunications Technician
